Phase IV – Well Creek Dredging January 2018

British Legion Footbridge, Upwell to Isle Bridge, Outwell

Please be advised that the Middle Level Commissioners will be commencing the fourth phase of their programmed de-silting/dredging works along Well Creek between the British Legion Footbridge, Upwell and Isle Bridge, Outwell. The dredging works will be undertaken using a long reach hydraulic excavator working from the adjacent A1101 Town Street. It is proposed that the works will commence on Sunday 7th January 2018 starting from the British Legion Footbridge end. The works will be undertaken under traffic light control and a temporary road traffic restriction along the riverside carriageway, which has been arranged in conjunction with Norfolk County Highways, will be in place along Town Street for the duration of the dredging work. Access to residential properties and businesses will not be affected. However, on-road parking directly in front of residential properties and businesses may be affected for a short period of time as the dredging work progresses.

The Middle Level Commissioners will be working in partnership with the Well Creek Trust to assist and liaise with boat owners along the affected reach to move boats from their moorings temporarily, prior to the dredging works passing their mooring site. If you have a boat mooring in front of your property you will be required to temporarily move the boat to facilitate the dredging works. I shall be pleased if you will kindly telephone the Well Creek Trust Chairman, Grahame Seaton, on 01945 772632 to arrange the date and time when your boat will be required to be moved from its mooring to facilitate the dredging work.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your anticipated help and assistance with this matter in advance of the dredging works commencing.
