The Middle Level Commissioners

Public Body & Charitable Land Ownership

The Middle Level Act 1862 (Clause 56) states that;

“every corporation, or body of commissioners, or trustees for charitable or other public purposes, being seised or possessed of or entitled to 100 acres of land liable to be taxed by the Middle Level Commissioners, shall be and are hereby authorised to act as Middle Level Commissioners”.

When there is more than one trustee, committee, or guardian for the same land, only one person shall act as a Commissioner. One member or officer can act as a Commissioner on behalf of a corporation.

You will need to inform us if your land ownership reduces to below 100 acres and step down as a Commissioner.

The definitions and clauses within the Middle Level Acts do not reflect modern day arrangements, for example; partnerships, limited companies or overseas investors. You will need to consider how your specific arrangements fit.

Reasonable assurance checks of eligibility will be undertaken.
